The Cambridge Building Society Community Fund offers grants to support local voluntary groups, community groups and organisations that are undertaking charitable work with a connection to homes or housing. This might include projects that:

- enable access to housing and homes for all
- tackle homelessness issues
- support vulnerable people with their housing needs
- give advice about housing
- help vulnerable people into a home
- support people to thrive in their homes

Grants of between £2,500 and £10,000 will be made to assist charitable projects located within a 15 mile radius of The Cambridge's branch and store network. You can check the branch finder [here](#).
